Dan Churay Takes Top Legal Spot as Bill Martin Retires

OVERLAND PARK, Kan., Aug 29, 2002 -- Bill Zollars, chairman, president and chief executive officer of Yellow Corporation (Nasdaq: YELL), announced today that Daniel J.
